Pender Islands Parks and Recreation Commission

The PIPRC manages local parks on behalf of the CRD for the use and enjoyment of all Pender residents and visitors with a budget of about \$100,000. Local parks include our many Ocean Accesses and Viewpoints, many trails, and major park areas including Thieves Bay, Shingle Bay, and Magic Lake Swimming Hole. The PIPRC also allocates annually recreation funding to various Community Groups (totaling about \$50,000).

The Commission consists of 8 volunteers working together - decisions and actions are by the Commission as a whole. Commissioners serve a 2-year term extendable to 3 terms. Meetings are open to the public.

There are no prerequisite skill sets other than a desire to serve our community and an interest and enjoyment of our local parks and trails. We meet each month normally on the 3rd Friday, 9 am in the Plum Tree Court Community Room.

Pender is renowned for its volunteers in all aspects of our lives. Serving as a Parks Commissioner is a great way to give back (and pay ahead) to your community.
